After lunch they went to San Giuliano di Puglia and visited the town, Museum METE, “Parco della memoria” in memory of the tragedy of the 2002 earthquake. In the evening they saw a opera concert by the association “Atena”.

# 5th June : Day 2

On Wednesday there were the official opening of the “Erasmus+ event” at school, with the presentations of the Italian and the partners schools. They used “h5p” for the activity: in teams (one for each Country) they created a timeline about a famous person of their own Nation.



They went to Collettorto for lunch and then they visited the old town of Collettorto. They admired the view from the top of the tower.

# 6th June : Day 3

On Thursday they used the Pixton app: in mixed teams each group created a comic.



They went to Termoli by bus and had lunch at the “Hotel Europa”. In the afternoon they visited the old town of Termoli and the Castle with a guide.





# 7th June: Day 4

*On Fryday they went to Isernia and visited the “Paleolithic Museum” with a guide.*

*The National Paleolithic Museum of Isernia is part of a project of an archaeological park. It develops around the Isernia La Pineta deposit which, for its importance and its antiquity, is considered one of the main prehistoric archaeological sites*



# 7th June: Day 4

*In the afternoon they visited the Marinelli's foundry with a guide and after that they visited the city of Agnone.*



*The Marinelli Pontifical Bell Foundry is an Italian family-run metallurgical company based in Agnone, in the province of Isernia, specialized in bell construction. Owned by the Marinelli family, which has managed it for many generations, it stands out as the oldest Italian foundry and among the oldest family businesses in the world.*

# 8th June : Day 5

On Saturday the teams used Learning Apps to create a puzzle about the Paleolithic Museum and Marinelli's foundry and Incredibox app to record a song.



Then everybody received the certificate of attendance.



# 8th June : Day 5

In the afternoon they went to farm Paladino: they saw the preparation of the “treccia”, a typical mozzarella of Santa Croce di Magliano and tasted other typical cheeses.
